



## Uniform Policy of Scoil Bhríde, Eglantine

School policies are created through a process of consultation and collaboration between the staff, the Parents Association and the Board of Management.

### Aim

The aim of this policy is to clarify what uniform should be worn and when.

### **SCOIL BHRÍDE EGLANTINE UNIFORM**

All pupils of Scoil Bhríde, Eglantine are required to wear the following uniform during school: *All of the items in our uniform are available locally. Most items are purchasable from various stores.*

#### Main Uniform:

- Green pinafore (Stocked in Laura's; Dosco Business Park, South Douglas Road, Cork)
- Green cardigan (Stocked in Laura's; Dosco Business Park, South Douglas Road, Cork)
- Cream shirt
- Green tie
- Cream or green tights or socks
- Shoes: All pupils must wear dark, flat shoes
- School Jacket (Optional)

#### P.E. Uniform:

- Green school tracksuit
- White polo shirt
- Supportive sports runners

Pupils are required to wear a tracksuit as outlined for P.E. It cannot be worn as an alternative to the school uniform at any other time. Pupils will be informed when they are required to wear the tracksuit.

#### Summer Uniform:

- P.E. white polo shirt
- Green culottes
- Green tracksuit top.

This uniform may be worn during the months of September, October, May and June. It must be worn with green or white socks and dark, flat shoes or runners.

## **HEALTH & SAFETY**

### Jewellery, Make-up and Accessories:

- The only jewellery that is permitted is stud earrings and watches.
- Children are not permitted to wear false nails, nail polish or make up.

### Footwear:

- Pupils should wear dark, flat school shoes on all days, except P.E. days.
- Boots are not permitted

### Hair:

- Parents are advised that long hair should be 'tied back' every day to reduce the risk of spreading or contracting head lice. Hair may not be dyed.
- Discreet hair accessories are permitted

## **DISCIPLINE**

- In order to respect the integrity of the uniform and limit time-wasting, pupils and parents are asked to observe the school Uniform Policy.
- Pupils are not allowed to wear non-uniform hoodies, scarves or other garments over their school uniform during class time.
- Particular fashion trends deemed by school management from time to time, to be inappropriate for school will be prohibited under this policy.

## **ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES**

### Pupils & Parents:

- The correct uniform must be worn at all times.
- Pupils should be neat and tidy in their appearance.
- All items belonging to a pupil should be clearly labelled.
- Parents must send a note to explain incomplete uniform or any deviation from the uniform policy.

### School Staff:

- Teachers will monitor school uniform regularly.
- Uniform checks by the Principal/Deputy Principal will take place regularly.
- Deviation from the uniform may merit a note from the class teacher.
- In consultation with the class teacher, the school management will use its discretion in supporting pupils towards complying with the school Uniform Policy.
- Any families experiencing difficulties may talk with the School Principal for assistance regarding uniform related purchases. All such discussions will be treated in the strictest confidence.
